Music Notes: The organ music today is in tribute to Johann Sebastian Bach upon the 260th anniversary of his death on July 28, 1750, and to Martin Luther, whose chorale texts were often harmonized by Bach. Marilyn just completed an inspirational pilgrimage to the eastern German cities where Luther and Bach lived two centuries apart: Wittenburg, Eisenach, Arnstadt, Kothen, Leipzig, Mulhausen and Weimar. Music selections during communion are various chorales from Luther's 1524 hymnbook which were later harmonized by Bach.
