## Sunday School

We are blessed to have loving, trained volunteer teachers for ages 3 years through 5th grade. Our students learn all about Jesus and His teachings through "The Gospel Project" curriculum.

### Fall Sunday School

September through May, we offer Sunday School from 9:30-10:30 a.m.

Parents attending the 9 a.m. Contemporary Service should bring their children to worship. The students will be dismissed to Sunday School from there. Parents attending the 9:30 a.m. Traditional Service can drop their children off in the Sunday School classrooms anytime after 9:20 a.m.

### Summer Sunday School

June through August, we offer a combined-age Sunday School.

All new and returning students must register online each year to ensure we have the most up-to-date contact and medical on file.

## Nursery

We strive to provide a safe, fun and loving environment for your precious little ones while you attend Sunday worship or adult education programs. 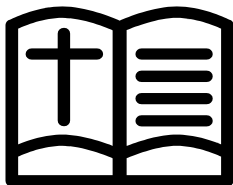

Each spring our 3rd graders attend this class to help the children and their parents more fully understand the Sacrament of Communion. It's an informative and memorable afternoon for everyone.

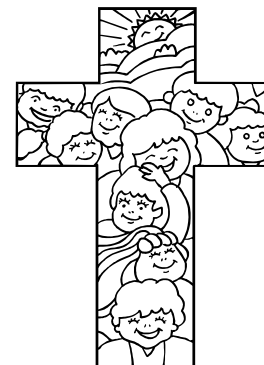
## Vacation Bible School Each Summer
